Welcome to Habitat for Humanity. Thank you for volunteering with us!

Build Days: Every Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday from 8:00 am to 3:30 pm. No experience necessary.

LOCATION: 290 School Addition Rd. Somers, Montana

WHAT TO WEAR:

- Closed-toe shoes. You will not be allowed to volunteer on site if you wear sandals or flip flops.
- Wear clothes that you don't mind getting dirty or paint on.
- We work year-round, so be sure to wear appropriate clothing for all types of weather! Think layers!

WHAT TO BRING:

- Water bottle
- Lunch is usually provided. Habitat staff will let you know if you need to bring a lunch. Please bring your own food if you have allergies.
- We have all the tools and safety equipment necessary.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- All valuables including jewelry.
- Personal power tools.
- The build site is **NON-SMOKING/VAPING**.

Volunteers are asked to participate in numerous construction tasks, including preparing the lots, framing walls, painting, siding, insulating and tiling. The tasks for the day depend on what needs to be done, what previous volunteers have already accomplished and what materials are available that day.

All volunteers must be 18 years of age or older.

BUILD DAY SCHEDULE:

7:45-8:00 am	Volunteers arrive, sign-in
8:00 am	Site supervisor provides morning orientation, safety talk and assigns tasks.
8:15-11:30 am	Work on assigned task
11:30 am-12:00 pm	Lunch
12:00-3:00 pm	Back to assigned task
3:00-3:30 pm	Clean Up
